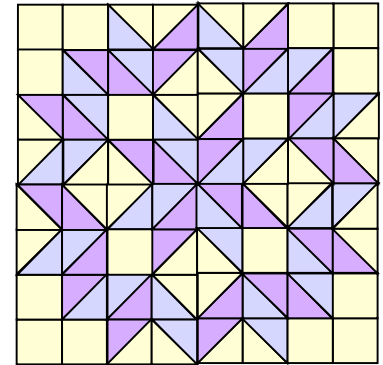


Center Medallion for the 2007 Block of the month.

For the Medallion, you will need three fabrics; one background, and a light and dark of the same color family. This makes a 24 inch medallion.



Cutting instructions:

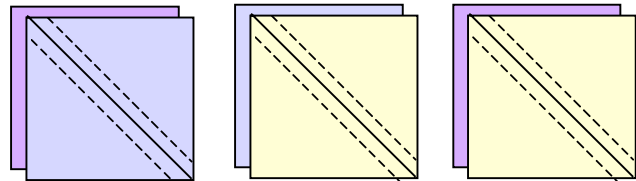
From the background fabric, cut sixteen $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares and sixteen $3\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares. On the $3\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares mark one diagonal.

From the dark fabric cut sixteen $3\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares.

From the light fabric cut sixteen $3\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares. On eight of them mark one diagonal.

Sewing instructions:

Match the eight light squares which have been marked on the diagonal with eight dark squares. Match eight of the $3\frac{7}{8}$ inch background with eight of the light $3\frac{7}{8}$ squares. Lastly, match the last eight of the $3\frac{7}{8}$ inch background fabrics with eight of the dark $3\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares. You will have a total of 24 paired up squares. On each pair sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam on each side of the drawn diagonal. Cut on the drawn line and press to the dark. You will have eight pairs of light and background, eight pairs of dark and background and eight pairs of light and dark.



Assembly instructions:

Create rows as shown –

| Row 4 - | | iron to the right |
| Row 5 - | | iron to the left |
| Row 6 - | | iron to the right |
| Row 7 - | | iron to the left |
| Row 8 - | | iron to the right |

For a 12 inch medallion – cut squares 2 inch and $2\frac{7}{8}$ inch

For a 18 inch medallion – cut squares $2\frac{3}{4}$ and $3\frac{1}{8}$ inch
