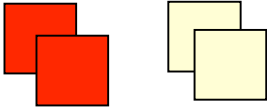


Churn Dash Block

12 inch block

For your two-color quilt select 2 fabrics, one in each color. For the purpose of these instructions, we will use red and cream.

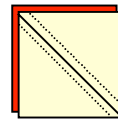
Cut two $4\frac{7}{8}$ squares from each color for a total of four squares.



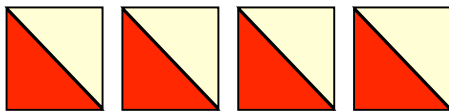
Match one square of each color, right sides together.



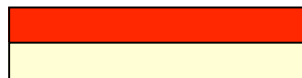
On the lighter fabric draw a diagonal line and sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch on either side. Cut on the drawn line and press towards the darker fabric.



There will be a total of four half square triangle blocks.



Cut one 18 by $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles from each color. Sew the two fabric right side together on the long edge. Iron to the dark.

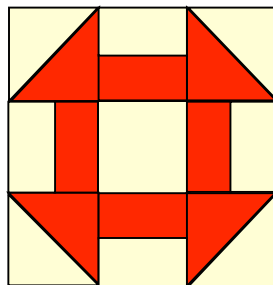


Sub cut the two color rectangle into $4\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares.



Cut one $4\frac{1}{2}$ inch square of the lighter fabric.

Assemble like a 9-patch



Different sizes of the Churn Dash Block

- 9-inch block – cut $3\frac{7}{8}$ inches for the half square triangle blocks, cut rectangles 14 by 2 inch sub cut into $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares and $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches for the center.
- 6 inch block – cut $2\frac{7}{8}$ inches for the half square triangle blocks, cut rectangles 10 by $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches sub cut into $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches squares and $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches for the center.
- 3 inch block – cut $1\frac{7}{8}$ inches for the half square triangle blocks, cut rectangles 6 by 1 inch sub cut into $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches squares and $1\frac{1}{2}$ for the center.
