
Diamond Star Block


12 inch block



For your two-color quilt select one fabric in each color.



Cut six 3-7/8 squares from color A and six from color B, for a total of twelve squares.



Match one square of each color, right sides together.




On the lighter fabric draw a diagonal line and sew a scant 1/4-inch on either side. Cut on the drawn line and press towards the darker fabric.




There will be a total of twelve half square triangle blocks. These should measure 3-1/2 inches.



Cut four 3-1/2 inch squares of color B fabric.



Assemble into rows and then into the block.



Different size blocks from the Diamond Star Block

- 9-inch block cut 3-1/4 inches for the half square triangle blocks, cut squares 2-3/4 inches
- 6-inch block cut 2-3/8 inches for the half square triangle blocks, cut squares 2-inches
- 3-inch block cut 1-5/8 inches for the half square triangle blocks, cut squares 1-1/4 inches
