

# Ribbon Quilt Block

12 inch block

For your two-color quilt select 4 fabrics, two in each color. For the purpose of these instructions, we will use red and cream.

Cut two  $4\frac{7}{8}$  inch squares from each fabric for a total of 8 squares.

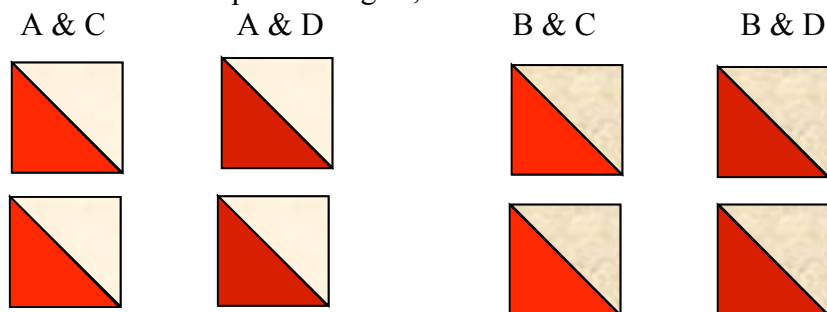


Match A with C and A with D, B with C and B with D with sides together.

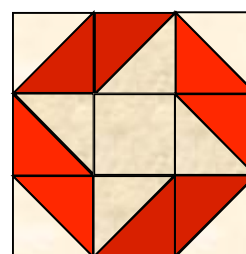
On the lighter fabric draw a diagonal line and sew a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch on either side. Cut on the drawn line and press towards the dark.



There will be a total of 8 half square triangles, two of each combination.



Cut one  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in square of color C. Assemble block like a 9-patch.



## Different size blocks from the Ribbon Quilt Block

9-inch block cut all of the half square triangle blocks start out as  $3\frac{7}{8}$  inches and the center block  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches.

6-inch block cut all of the half square triangle blocks out as  $2\frac{7}{8}$  inches and the center block  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches

3-inch block cut all of the half square triangle blocks out as  $1\frac{7}{8}$  inches and the center block at  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches.

To make the final layout easier keep the blocks in sizes divisible by 3.
