Ribbon Quilt Block

12 inch block

For your two-color quilt select 4 fabrics, two in each color. For the purpose of these instructions, we will use red and cream.


Cut two 4-7/8 inch squares from each fabric for a total of 8 squares.




Match A with C and A with D, B with C and B with D with sides together.

On the lighter fabric draw a diagonal line and sew a scant 1/4-inch on either side. Cut on the drawn line and press towards the dark.

There will be a total of 8 half square triangles, two of each combination.



Cut one 4-1/2 in square of color C. Assemble block like a 9-patch.



Different size blocks from the Ribbon Quilt Block

9-inch block cut all of the half square triangle blocks start out as 3-7/8 inches and the center block 3-1/2 inches.

6-inch block cut all of the half square triangle blocks out as 2-7/8 inches and the center block 2-1/2 inches

3-inch block cut all of the half square triangle blocks out as 1-7/8 inches and the center block at 1-1/2 inches.

To make the final layout easier keep the blocks in sizes divisible by 3.
