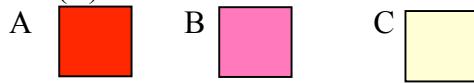


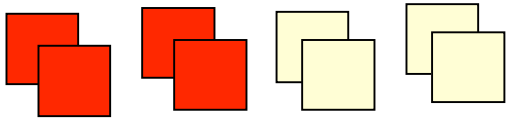
Shooting Star 2 Block

12 inch block

For your two-color quilt select 3 fabrics. Select two fabrics, a medium and a dark in one color family. The third fabric should be from the other color family. For the purpose of these instructions, we will use red(A), pink(B) and cream(C).



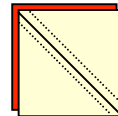
Cut four $3\frac{7}{8}$ squares from color A and four from color C for a total of 8 squares.



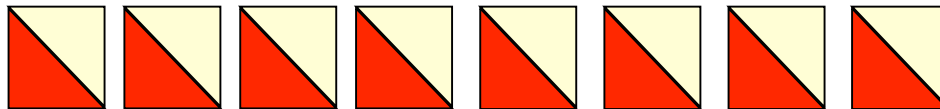
Match one square of each color, right sides together.



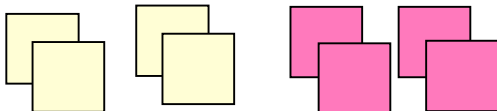
On the lighter fabric draw a diagonal line and sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch on either side. Cut on the drawn line and press towards the darker fabric.



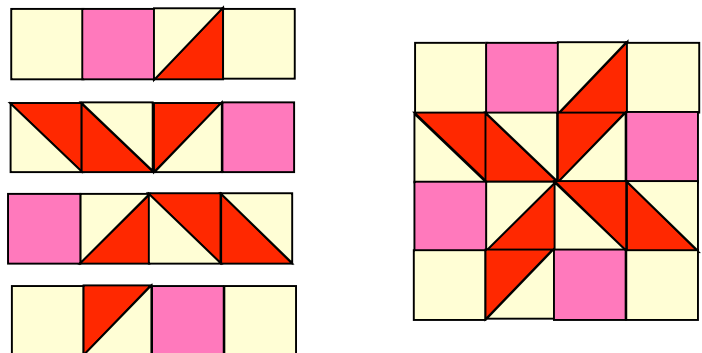
There will be a total of eight half square triangle blocks. These should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches.



Cut four $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares from of color C and four from color B



Assemble into rows and then into the block.



Different size blocks from the Shooting Star 2 Block

- 9-inch block cut $3\frac{1}{4}$ inches for the half square triangle blocks, cut squares $2\frac{3}{4}$ inches
- 6-inch block cut $2\frac{3}{8}$ inches for the half square triangle blocks, cut squares 2-inches
- 3-inch block cut $1\frac{5}{8}$ inches for the half square triangle blocks, cut squares $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches
