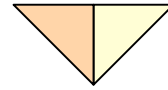
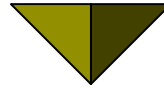


## Quilt Row Assembly

Select 16 setting triangles you cut as you made your snail trail blocks of background color. Sew these together by twos as shown.



Select 8 setting triangles you cut as you made your snail trail blocks of the main color. Sew these together by twos as shown.



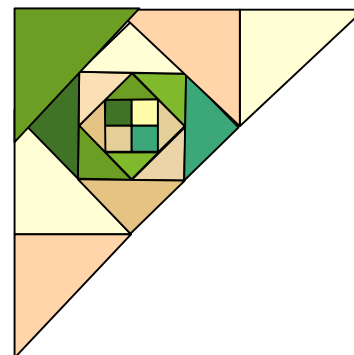
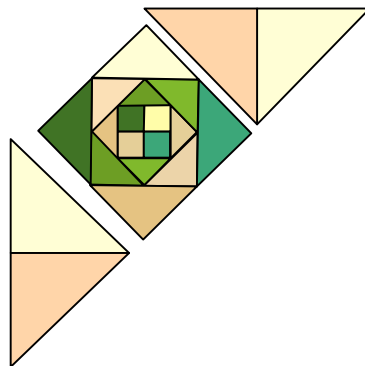
You will also need four triangles of main color fabric. These are for the corners.

(If you did not cut the setting triangles as you went along, they are 9 inch squares cut once on the diagonal.)

These triangles will be oversized and trimmed down before the first border is added.

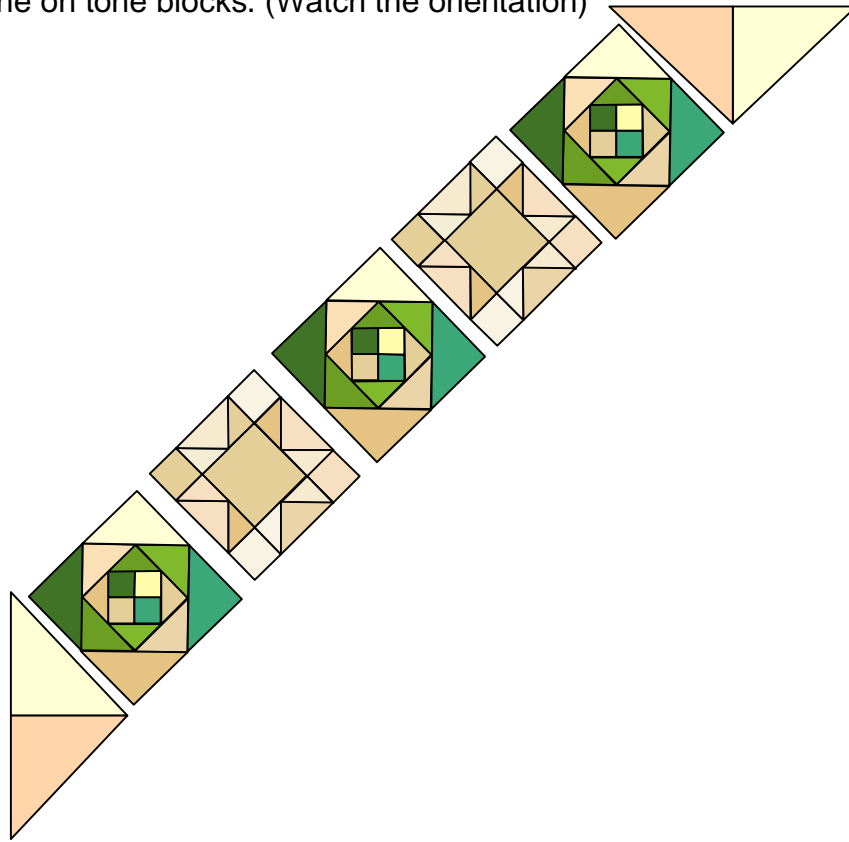
### Assembling rows

Row one and row seven are the same, they are made of one snail trail block and two background setting triangles. In each row it is important that the snail trail block be oriented correctly as shown.

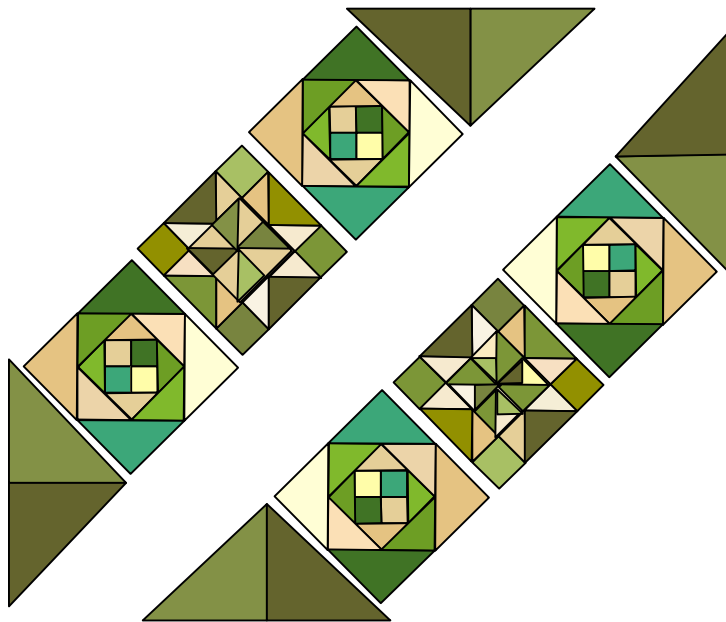


Add the setting corner triangle.

Row three and five are the same. They are made up of three snails trail blocks and two tone on tone blocks. (Watch the orientation)



The row two and row six are made up of one sawtooth star block and two snails trail blocks. (Note the different orientation of the snails trail blocks)



The last row to assemble is the fourth row. This row is made up of four snails trail blocks and three sawtooth star blocks. (Again, watch the orientations)
