Block 3 – Stars & Diamonds





Print 4 copies of each template at 100%. In addition to the background fabric listed above you will need:

To make placement easier, I take a colored marker and draw a line ¼ inch from the seam line as shown below. The first drawn line would be in section 2. That way I know where to place the first piece and line up the second piece (light) for a ¼ inch seam. Pin or use spray adhesive or a dab of fabric glue so the piece doesn't slip while you are moving or sewing.

Note that pieces 1 and 2 on the actual template are cut as one piece for a solid background.

<u>Block 4 – Wild Zinnia</u>


