

Mystery Quilt 2008 – Step 1


Focus Fabric - 

Cut five 6 1/2 x 6 1/2 inch squares. (fussy cut if desired)

Fabric A - 

Cut an 8 inch strip, sub cut into two 8 inch squares and eight 3 7/8 inch squares

Cut two 3 1/2 strips, sub cut four 6 1/2 x 3 1/2 inch units and twenty 3 1/2 inch squares.

Fabric B – 

Cut an 8 inch strip, sub cut into two 8 inch squares and eight 3 7/8 inch squares

Cut a 3 1/2 strip, sub cut six 6 1/2 x 3 1/2 inch units.


Cut a 3 1/2 inch width and cut two 6 1/2 by 3 1/2 inch units.

Fabric C – 

Cut six 1 1/2 inch strips WOF

Fabric D – 

Cut twelve 1 1/2 inch strips WOF

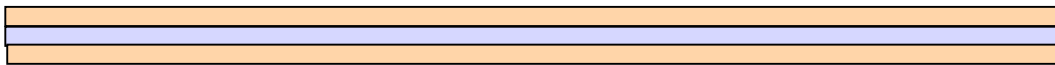
Inner Border – 

Cut four 1 1/2 inch strip WOF

Outer Border – 

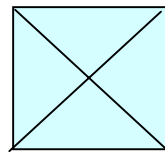
Cut four 3 1/2 inch strips WOF

Sew one strip of fabric C to one strip of fabric D. Now sew one strip of fabric D to the opposite side of fabric C. Make six sets.

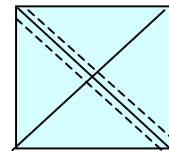


Making Quarter Square Units

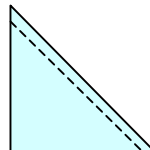
Make a diagonal line on the two 8 inch squares of fabric A and fabric B, from both corners.



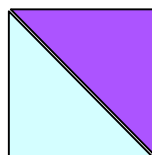
Place one fabric A on one fabric B square, right sides together and sew a scant 1/4 inch from each side of one of the diagonals.



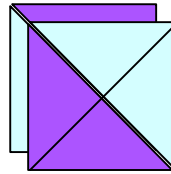
Cut between the sew lines.



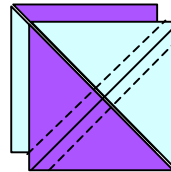
Press open



Line up two of the half squares units, right sides together so that the colors are on opposite sides.



Sew a scant quarter inch from the drawn line.



Cut between the sew lines and press open.

Trim the four squares to 6 1/2 inch.
