

Pinwheels on Parade

Material

2 blue strips – 4 inch by Width of Fabric
1 yellow strips – 4 inch by Width of Fabric
1 purple strips – 4 inch by Width of Fabric
1 green strips – 4 inch by Width of Fabric
1 reds strips – 4 inch by Width of Fabric
2 pink strips – 4 inch by Width of Fabric

1 1/2 yards of white

Cutting

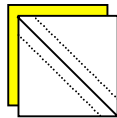
Sub cut into 4 inch squares from all strips
12 blue 4 inch squares
8 yellow 4 inch squares
4 purple 4 inch squares
8 green 4 inch squares
4 red 4 inch squares
12 pink 4 inch squares

Cut twenty four 6 1/2 squares from white yardage and
cut forty eight 4 inch squares from white yardage

Sewing Instructions

On all white 4 inch squares, mark a center diagonal line.

Match one white 4 inch square with one colored squares and sew a scant 1/4 inch on each side of the drawn line.

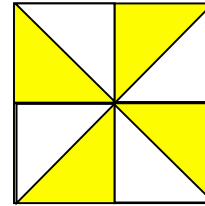


Cut on the drawn line and iron to the dark. You will have 96 half square triangle blocks. Square each of them up to measure 3 1/2 inches.

Pinwheel Block Assembly

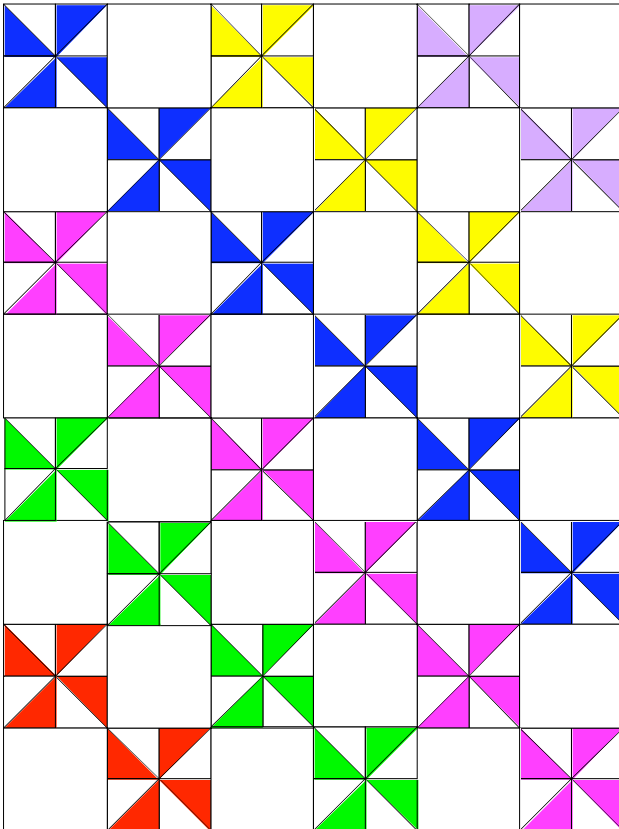
Select 4 half-square triangle block of the same color and construct a four patch, making sure that all of the color triangles face like in the drawing.

- Make 6 blue Pinwheels
- 4 Yellow Pinwheels
- 2 purple Pinwheels
- 4 green Pinwheels
- 2 red Pinwheels
- 6 pink Pinwheels



Quilt Assembly

Sew rows together as in the diagram. Iron the rows towards the plain blocks. Each row is different, so be careful.



This make a 36 by 48 quilt center, border as desired.
