

Dime Charm Quilt (Half Log Cabin)

Stack 10 inch squares, matching edges.

Cutting

From the outside left edge cut 1 strip $3\frac{1}{4}$ inches x 10. (C1)

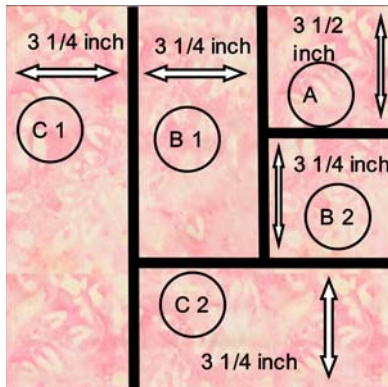
From the bottom edge cut $3\frac{1}{4}$ x $6\frac{3}{4}$ (C2)

From left edge cut $3\frac{1}{4}$ x $6\frac{3}{4}$ (B1)

From bottom cut $3\frac{1}{4}$ x $3\frac{1}{2}$ (B2)

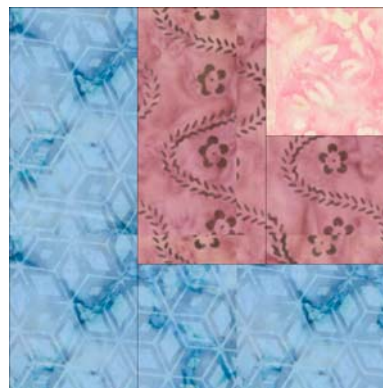
Remaining square will be $3\frac{1}{2}$ x $3\frac{1}{2}$ (A)

Mark pieces A, B1, B2, C1 and C2 as indicated.

With the stacks placed and marked as above, move 1 piece from the top of stacks B1 and B2 to the bottom of those stacks. For stacks, C1 and C2 move 2 strips from the top to the bottom of the stacks. (No fabrics will be moved from stack A)

The stacks should now resemble (fig.2) :

Sew A to B2. Press toward B2

Sew B1 to the A/B2 block. Press seam toward B1 and trim. (should be approx $\frac{1}{2}$ inch).

Sew C2 to B1/B2 side of block. Press seam toward C2 and trim excess.

Sew C1 to B1/C2 side of block. Press seam toward C1 and trim.

Block should measure 9 inches.

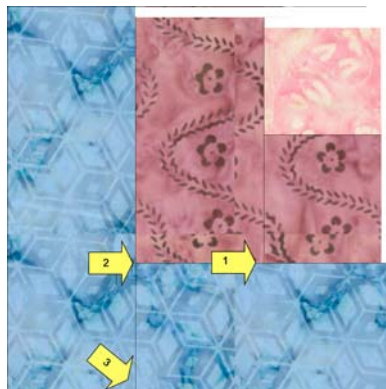
OR

Sew A to B2. Press toward B2

Sew B1 to the A/B2 block. Begin sewing at the left lower edge of A/B2 (fig.3, arrow 1). Press seam toward B1.

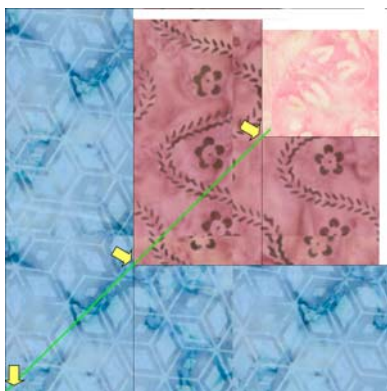
Sew C2 to B1/B2 side of block. Begin sewing at the left lower edge of B2/B1 (fig. 3, arrow 2). Press seam toward.

Sew C1 to B1/C2 side of block. Begin sewing at the left lower edge of C2 (fig. 3, arrow 3). Press seam toward C1.



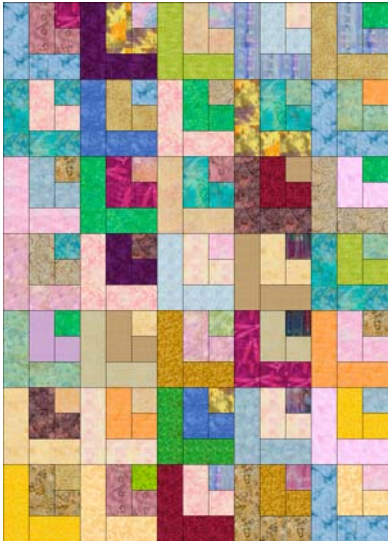
(Fig 3)

Cutting: Line up square ruler with the diagonal mark on the corners (as indicated by the green line on fig 5) and trim to a 9 inch square .



(fig 4)

Arrange blocks in a pleasing manner.



Sew blocks together and add borders if desired. Quilt and bind and desired.
