

RAGGEDY EDGE QUILT NOVEMBER SWAP

72 x 56

Rag Quilt Yardages

10. yards (total) assorted homespun for blocks and backing
4 1/2 yards flannel
1/2 yard for binding (optional)

Rag Quilt Cutting Chart

128 – 6 inch squares assorted homespun
94 – 10 inch squares assorted homespun
16 – stars from template
63 – 10 inch flannel squares
7- 2 1/2 inch strips for binding (optional)

Construction

All seams are 1 inch (unless otherwise noted)

Four patch blocks. Create four patch block by assembling four 6 inch blocks. Put two four patch squares wrong sides together and sew a 1 (one) inch seam (as shown). With wrong sides together sew the horizontal seam pushing previous seams in opposite directions.



You should have 32 – 10 inch four patch blocks. Layer 1- 10 inch homespun, 1- 10 inch flannel square and four patch with the seams of the four patch showing. Set aside.

Layer 1- 10 inch homespun, 1- 10 inch flannel and 1- 10 inch homespun. You should have 31. Select 16 – 10 inch sandwiches and sew on a star using a 1/2 inch seam. Template included

Lay out the four patch sandwich squares, star sandwich squares and plain sandwich squares as indicated in the picture:

During assembly place square sandwiches quilt backs together so that seams will be facing the top. Sew one inch seams. Assemble vertical rows. When assembling horizontal rows push seams different directions.



OPTIONAL BINDING- after all seams are sewn if you choose you may add a binding.

If no binding is used, using a narrow stitch, zig-zag one inch from edges.

Clip all seams to within $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from seam. Cuts should be $\frac{1}{2}$ inch apart. Clip raw edges around stars $\frac{1}{2}$ inch apart. If no binding is used clip the outside raw edges to $\frac{1}{2}$ inch, spacing cuts $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.

Check to see that all seams have been clipped.

Wash in regular cycle. When drying, check lint filter frequently as this quilt creates massive amounts of threads in the lint trap.
