Sticks n' Stones June Swap Quilt

Supplies:

2 ¹/₂ yards of large print
(40) 1 ¹/₂ in wide assorted strips Width of Fabric (WOF)
3/8 yard bright mottled fabric for setting stones
1 ¹/₂ yard dark mottled fabric for sashing

Cutting:


Large print- cut (6) $5\frac{1}{2}$ strips WOF for border and (17) $8\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares Bright mottled fabric- (48) $2\frac{1}{2}$ squares (for setting stones) Dark mottled fabric- (82) strips $2\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ (for sashing)


Construction:

Layout 1-1/2 inch strips in a pleasing manner and sew 5 sets of strips consisting of 8 strips each. Press all seams in one direction. (fig 1- without border)

Cut each strip set in to $8\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares.

Layout strip squares, print squares, sashing and setting stone pieces according to picture (fig 2): assemble horizontal rows first. Press seams in alternate directions to match up blocks when sewing vertical rows. Press all remaining seams in one direction.





Add borders to quilt. Press seams toward borders.

Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt as desired and add binding.
