

String Signature Block Quilt

(Finished Size: 46 x 62)

Supplies:

24 - 9 ½ inch square white (or light) fabric
Strips of fabric from 1 inch to 2 ½ inches in width.
½+ yard fabric inside border
¾+ yard fabric for outside border

Cutting:

Cut 9 ½ inch squares for foundation for block.
From inside border fabric, cut 5- 3½ inch strips.
From outside border fabric, cut 6- 4½ inch strips.

Assembly:

On foundation fabric, draw lines 1 inch from center on both sides of center.



Take strip of fabric and place next to line on inside of line. Sew with ¼ inch seam.



Press toward outside point. Repeat for opposite line.



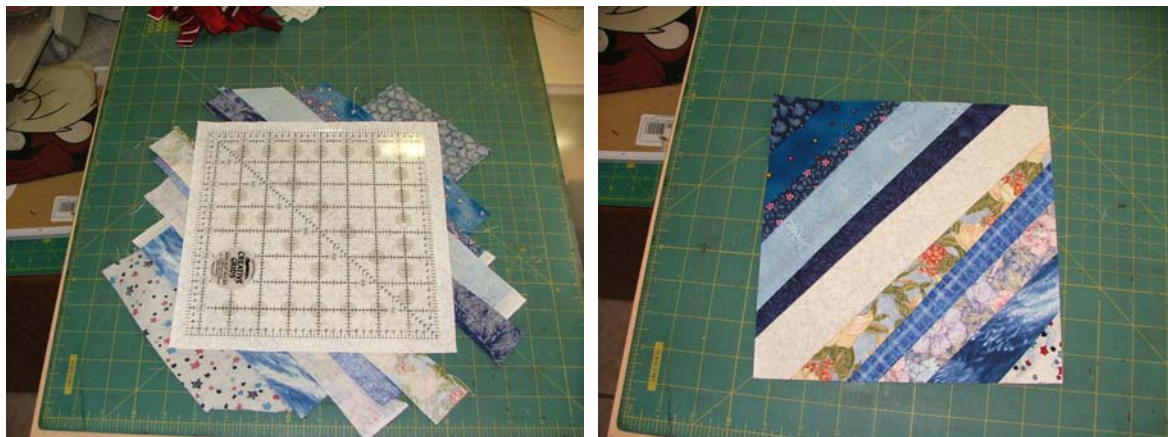
Begin adding random strips of fabric to strips using $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam. Strips may be sewn down at an angle to give more variety.



Add fabric strips to both sides until it covers the corners.



Press block well. Turn block over, line up center points to points on 8 ½ square ruler. Trim edges.



Assemble blocks 4 across by 6 down. Blocks may be laid out with white corners touching to create “stars”. I assembled mine all going one direction.

Add border with the smaller 3 ½ inch border first. Then add the remaining border.



Back, quilt and bind as desired.
