On Point Table Runner

Finished: 51 x 17

Supplies:

- $3 2\frac{1}{2}$ inch strips (width of fabric) medium light color
- $3-2\frac{1}{2}$ inch strips (width of fabric) medium color
- $3-2\frac{1}{2}$ inch strips (width of fabric) dark color
- $2 8\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares (sub cut diagonally on both diagonals to make a total of 8 quarter square triangles) Backing 53 x 19 inches

Batting 53 x 19 inches

Binding

Construction:

Arrange one of each strip in a desirable order (fig 1). Strip piece together so you have a strata with 3 different colors (fig 2). Do the same with the remaining strips.

Subcut the assembled strips in to 6 ½ inch squares.

Layout 12 of the 6 ½ inch blocks as indicated below (fig 3) and sew together to create 3-12 inch blocks.




Lay out the three 12 inch blocks, four $6\frac{1}{2}$ inch blocks and eight quarter square triangles according to the diagram. (fig 4)

Sew together. The quarter square triangles will need to be trimmed after table runner is sewn together.

After sewing together and trimming, layer backing, batting and table runner. Quilt as desired and finish with binding.
